SCRIPTURE PASSAGE: "For this reason I bow my knees before the Father...that according to the riches of his glory he may grant you to be strengthened with power through his Spiritin your inner being, so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith—that you, being rooted and grounded in love, may have strength to comprehend with all the saints what is the breadth and length and height and depth, and to know the love of Christ that surpasses knowledge, that you may be filled with all the fullness of God."

Ephesians 3:14-19

#### LET US PRAY

Heavenly Father, awaken, refine and renew us through the loving action of your Holy Spirit, so that we are ready and able to live life to the full. Amen.

If you have a sense that it would be good to contact one or more of the people you have been praying for, perhaps a card, text, or call letting them know you have been praying for them. It might help their faith grow.

### INTRODUCTION

For over a century it has been a tradition within in the Catholic Church to pray for a fresh outpouring of the Holy Spirit in the days between the Ascension and Pentecost. In the Acts of the Apostles, once the apostles see Jesus ascend into heaven, they gather in continuous prayer with Mary, the mother of Jesus.

St Louis de Montfort reminds us that one way we can reach Jesus is through Mary, His mother. Throughout her life, Mary points us towards Jesus: she assents to His conception at the Annunciation; ponders the events at His Nativity and prompts her Son to perform His first miracle at Cana.

Journeying with Mary from the Ascension to Pentecost can help us to give assent to God's will in our lives, contemplate his call and be inspired to act. We can do this because we are reassured by Mary's words to the servants at the Wedding Feast – "do whatever he tells you" (John 2:5). Who better, therefore, than Mary to accompany us as we pray for a new Pentecost?



Titus 3:5

#### LET US PRAY

Jesus Christ, you are our Saviour, please pour your loving mercy on those we bring to you today, so that when they seek you, they will find you and be transformed through the power of your Holy Spirit. Amen.

## Monday: The God who Gives

PRAYER INTENTION: We pray for those we are holding in prayer to experience the generosity of our heavenly Father through Jesus Christ.

SCRIPTURE PASSAGE: "Take delight in the Lord, and He will give you the desires of your heart."

Come Holy Spirit and draw us near to the Lord our God. Help us to open our hearts to Jesus Christ so that our desires are purified and we are ready to receive the loving generosity of God our Father. Through Christ our Lord. Amen.

## PATTERN OF PRAYER

#### 1. INVOCATION TO OUR LADY

Mary, our Mother, you stayed with the disciples in those ten long days from the Ascension to Pentecost, still patient, still pondering, still trusting in your Son.

Be with us now as we remember how Jesus was taken from your sight. Be with us now as we remember his call to share our faith. Be with us now as we await his Holy Spirit.

Pray with us now, 'Come Holy Spirit', 'Thy Kingdom come'.

- **2. THEME OF THE DAY** Take a moment to consider what this might mean to the people you are praying for.
- **3. PRAYER INTENTION** Pray this for your five people.
- 4. SCRIPTURE PASSAGE For you to reflect upon
- **5. PRAYER RESPONSE (LET US PRAY)** followed by the prayers below. Alternatively, a decade or a mystery of the rosary may be said instead of the following prayers.

**OUR FATHER**, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name; thy kingdom come; thy will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread, and forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us; and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. Amen.

**HAIL MARY**, full of grace, the Lord is with thee. Blessed art thou amongst women and blessed is the fruit of thy womb, Jesus. Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us sinners, now and at the hour of our death. Amen.

**GLORY BE** to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit: as it was in the beginning, is now, and ever shall be, world without end. Amen.

## **Ascension Thursday**

PRAYER INTENTION: We pray for the courage to offer to Jesus those who we would like to become friends with him.

SCRIPTURE PASSAGE: He said, 'all authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go, therefore, make disciples of all the nations'.

Matthew 28:18-19a

#### LET US PRAY

Lord Jesus Christ, as you ascended to the Father you called us to 'make disciples of all nations'. Help me to share my faith in all that I say and do, so that others may come to know you as friend and saviour. Amen.

## Friday: The God who Loves

PRAYER INTENTION: We pray for... [bring to mind your five people] to experience the unconditional love of God our Father through Jesus Christ.

SCRIPTURE PASSAGE: "Beloved, since God so loved us, we also ought to love one another. No one has ever seen God; but if we love one another, God lives in us, and his love is made perfect in us."

1 John 4:11-12

#### LET US PRAY

Lord Jesus Christ, help us to reveal the love of God our Father in our relationships. Help us to share the reason for the hope we have in you when people ask, so that they too can know what it is to be loved by our heavenly Father. Amen.

## Saturday: The God who Speaks

PRAYER INTENTION: We pray for our five people to encounter the God who speaks to them, especially when most in need.

SCRIPTURE PASSAGE: Long ago, at many times and in many ways, God spoke to our fathers by the prophets, but in these last days he has spoken to us by his Son, whom he appointed the heir of all things, through whom also he created the world.

Hebrews 1:1-3

#### LET US PRAY

Heavenly Father, may we all come to know and recognise your voice as you speak into our lives and reveal your perfect love for us. Through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

## Sunday: The God who Creates

PRAYER INTENTION: We pray for our five people to experience the glory of God through his creation so they can see that they too are his work of art.

Ephesians 2:10

#### LET US PRAY

Come Holy Spirit, hover over what seems bleak and chaotic so that we might notice how you transform, inspire and order our lives and all creation so we reveal the glory of God. We make this prayer through Jesus Christ our Lord, Amen.
