CONTACT THE ELDERLY

• Contact the Elderly organise monthly Sunday afternoon tea parties for small groups of isolated older people aged 75 and over.

•There are four parish groups in Westminster, and three in development, two of which are in the Watford Deanery.



PLUS CLUB, HEMEL HEMPSTEAD

•A monthly Sunday afternoon club for individuals with intellectual disabilities and their families. Based on the Caritas St Joseph's Saturday club model, and organised through the Hemel Hempstead Caritas group, this is a safe, welcoming and inclusive space for play and social activities.



LOVE IN ACTION

• A programme to engage parishes in Catholic Social Teaching, and promote social action in the parish. New or improved parish social action is the intended outcome.

• A pilot project has been completed at Holy Rood parish, Watford.



FOOD BANKS

•We support a network of foodbanks. This year we have moved over 640kg of surplus food from St Albans to struggling foodbanks in Bow and Archway.
