

Information to Parishes and Groups for the Diocesan Pilgrimage to Walsingham: 23rd September 2023

It is the nominated Coach Marshal or Co-ordinator's responsibility to:

- Complete this form to register their Parish's/Group's intention to participate in the Diocesan Pilgrimage to Walsingham and send it to the Pilgrimage Office by post or email (details below).
- Make a coach reservation with a <u>reputable</u> coach company and collect payment from pilgrims travelling with them (including the additional £5 pp Pilgrimage Levy fee) from their Parish/Group
- Collect copies of Diocese of Westminster Walsingham Pilgrimage Booklets totalling the number of Parish/Group pilgrim participants as they arrive at Walsingham
- Transfer the total of their Parish/Group's Pilgrimage Levy Fee a suggested minimum of £5 per pilgrim – under separate cover, either by cheque, made out to WRCDT Walsingham Pilgrimage and sent to the address below with your Parish/Group name as a reference, or by bank transfer to:
